Dr. Yukio Kamino is Senior Researcher & Coordinator of OISCA International — a Japan-based transnational NGO for ecologically sustainable development worldwide. After graduating from Keio University (Tokyo, 1977), he had a long scholarly journey in social sciences and philosophy in the USA, attaining an M.A. from University of Colorado (1984) and a Ph.D. in International Studies from University of Denver (1999). Concerned with African suffering, he dedicated both M.A. and Ph.D. theses to African issues, and later coordinated a compilation of proposals from 14 NGOs based in six Asian

countries on the UN's role for African sustainable development (2001). His focus in this century has been on accelerating the worldwide evolution of human consciousness for ecological sustainability. He was the program organizer for the Global Forum on Education for a Sustainable Future: Promoting Earth Ethics (Tokyo, 2001), and Chief Facilitator for the Movement to Promote 'UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development' (Japan Forum for Johannesburg) at the World Summit on Sustainable Development (Johannesburg, 2002), contributing to the adoption of the Decade by the UN General Assembly for 2005-2014.
