# Background

President Joko Widodo, at the opening session of Asian-African Summit meeting on 22 April 2015, reminded the participants on the importance of the final communique of the 1955 Asian - African Conference with the so-called Bandung Spirit. In that moment, the President urged all participants to bring back the Bandung Spirit to the public and highlight the three main objectives being delivered by the initiators.

The objectives include achieving the prosperity through cooperation and poverty alleviation, improving the quality of education and health services; solidarity extension by empowering and developing the trade and investment among Asian and African nations; achieving internal and external stability and upholding human dignity.

It has been seven years of the President's appeal in 2015 and sixty-seven years of the 1955 Asia-Africa summit. It is now the momentum to take the idea of what dreams are, what challenges need to be, what projects can be put forward to make those dreams come true?

The Bandung-Belgrade-Havana Conference in Global History and Perspectives is held to answer these questions. The conference will focus on the "legacy" and "beyond the legacy" of the 1955 Asian-African Conference. Furthermore, this conference is to commemorate the 61st anniversary of the Non-Aligned Countries Conference in Belgrade and the 55th anniversary of the Tricontinental Havana Conference.



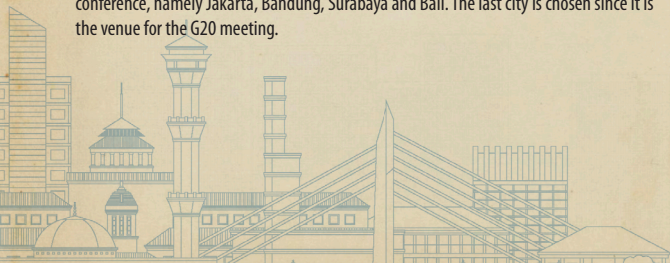

Both are the follow-up meetings of the 1955 Asia-Africa Conference. Indonesia's role to host the conference is out of question. The three conferences as well as the initiators gathered in the events due to the support from Indonesia and President Sukarno. The global peace, justice and prosperity which were appealed in the conferences, are still relevant to the current world situation.

In addition, Indonesia is also elected as the chairman of the G20 from December 1, 2021, to November 30, 2022. The 17th of the G20 meeting will be held in Bali on November 15-16, 2022. Therefore, it will be a historical moment for the scholars and social movement activists of the Bandung Spirit to hold the conference prior to the G20 meeting.

The National Archives of the Republic of Indonesia (ANRI), in collaboration with the Bandung Spirit Scholars and Social Movement activists through Mr. Darwis Khudori from the University of Le Havre Normandy, France, will participate in the conference. It is a great opportunity for ANRI to host the conference in Jakarta.

The conference itself will take place in 4 major cities related to the spirit of the Asia-Africa conference, namely Jakarta, Bandung, Surabaya and Bali. The last city is chosen since it is the venue for the G20 meeting.

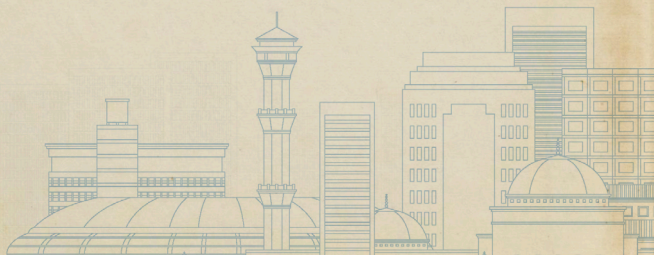
## *Medical Support*

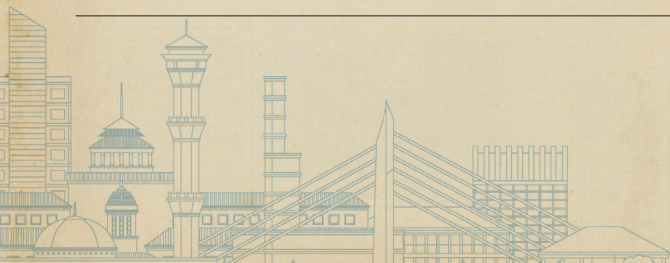
