The existing world order contributes to the growth of increasing technological and social inequality between the countries of the Global North and the countries of the Global South, the expansion of the scope of military operations that threaten to develop into large-scale WWIII.

The desire of the countries of the Global South for a more just world order and a peaceful resolution of the global crisis is expressed in their desire to join the BRICS. In this regard within the framework of the current Conference, it is important to organize a round-table on the Formation of a bipolar world “Global North - Global South”, to discuss the following issues:

- What is the current world order, why is the inequality of the countries of the Global North and the Global South growing and the war zone is expanding?
- Will the expanded BRICS be able to change the existing world order?
- How can the well-known global projects “Inclusive Capitalism”, “Industry 4.0”, “Great Reset”, “New Green Deal”, “One Belt, One Road” and others affect the current world order?
- What impact will military expansion have on the economies of the USA, EU, BRICS, China, India, Russia, Ukraine, Palestine, Israel and other countries (blocs), as well as on changes in the world order?
- The role of digital technologies in transforming the economy and society in the Global North and Global South;
- What is the alternative to the current world order and is it possible to form a bipolar world “Global North - Global South”.
- The need to organize an international consensus in the implementation of the cybernetic approach to establishing a new world order, ensuring the proportional development of the world economy and the implementation of moral values.
